

## Declaration by Dr Marion Guillou, President of the Institut National de la Recherche Agronomique

L'Inra en Europe conference of February 22<sup>nd</sup> 2006

In response to the publication by the European Commission of a Recommendation for a European Charter for Researchers and a Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers, and following the *L'Inra en Europe* Conference which was organised by the Directors and the Scientific Council of the Institut National de la Recherche Agronomique:

Dr Marion Guillou committed the Institute to working towards implementing the principles defined in the Charter and Code where these are not already common practice.

"[...] I declare solemnly that Inra will adhere to the Charter and Code shortly. This requires prior internal consultation and analysis of the various European statuses given to researchers. However, as a majority of the principles defined by the Charter and Code are already implemented in France, Inra will naturally commit to them."
